- have the ability to motivate and lead students

The Governors would like to appoint someone who can demonstrate their ability to:

- motivate our students and stimulate their interest in Art;
- contribute to the expertise within our current team
- communicate effectively;
- ensure progress and improvement for all students;
- prioritise and manage time effectively
- hold excellent working relationships with students, parents and staff.

In addition, we are looking to appoint someone who:

- is an energetic, committed and creative professional;
- is prepared to work as part of a strong team;
- will be willing to contribute towards the development of the department and its resources;
- will be a committed tutor for a group of students;
- will be willing to contribute to extra-curricular activities within the school;
