

Results From November 2009 Parental Questionnaire

Many thanks to all parents who completed this questionnaire

We discovered that :

- 95.9 % of parents either agreed or strongly agreed that their child enjoys school- this was really good news!
- 98.4 % of parents either agreed or strongly agreed that school keeps their child safe.
- 93.4% of parents either agreed or strongly agreed that they are well informed about their child's progress; 95.3% feel that their child is making enough progress. Currently parents receive two mentoring profiles and a full report annually, alongside (except Year 11) 3 face to face meetings to discuss progress. If you have any feedback on the information given out showing your child's progress we would really welcome it. There is always a slip at the bottom of the mentoring profile form for your comments.
- 97.5% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that teaching is good at Cleeve School.
- 89.3% agreed or strongly agreed that the school helped them to support their child's learning. Specialist evenings are put on for parents of Year 9 and 11 students and there is a host of information available on the website- however as this percentage is not as high as some others we would welcome feedback on usefulness of that information and what else it would be useful for parents to receive.
- 85.8% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that the school helps their child to have a healthy lifestyle. As a response to this we are going to publish the 'eat' menu on our website, as the food is good quality and has a focus on healthy eating. We would welcome further feedback to understand this percentage better.
- 94.9% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that the school prepares their child well for the future.
- 93.7% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that the school meets their child's particular needs. We would welcome feedback from the parents who did not agree with this statement to understand which needs are not being met and review our provision accordingly.
- 85.6% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that unacceptable behaviour was dealt with effectively. In response to this we have reviewed and have decided to change our communication with victims of incidents as we recognise that we have not always fed back information regarding sanctions given to pupils who have behaved inappropriately, even though sanction would have been issued.
- 87.7% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that the school takes account of their concerns.
- 97.1% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that the school is led and managed effectively.
- Happily, 97.4% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that they are happy with their child's experience at school.
