- support their child's studies by adhering to the homework policy, checking and signing his/her homework diary or planner on a weekly basis
- attend parents' evenings and discussion about their child's progress

- do their classwork and homework to the very best of their ability
- show courtesy towards all members of the school community
- abide by the behaviour policy, the race equality policy, the policy on ICT as well as all other school policies
